

The present Session will have a focus on energy efficiency.

Participants

ENERMED Training Workshop is intended for promising junior staff to acquire a general training on energy issues and to better understand the challenges to come in the energy sector in the Mediterranean Region. Thus, participants will be enabling to transform those challenges in opportunities.

ENERMED targets candidates preferably with a professional experience of 3 to 5 years. In order to promote dialogue and optimize input, the number of participants will be limited to a maximum of 20. ENERMED workshop is designed to have balance participation between North and South.

Speakers

Speakers are leaders from energy companies and high level experts both external and from OME. While OME experts will cover topics pertaining to energy situation and perspectives in the Mediterranean region, external experts would talk about such topics as energy efficiency issues and exchange of experience.

Participants to ENERMED Training Workshops will acquire new insight on the energy context of the Mediterranean Region: energy sectors, actors, financing, regional cooperation, institutional framework, regional initiatives, risks, energy security, perspectives, energy efficiency and climate change, etc. Participants will gain insight through exchanges with the experts and among participants who represent various professional sectors and regional contexts.
